General Instructions:

Note:

1. The candidates are advised to carefully read all the instructions in the advertisement before filling the online application form.
2. The candidates are advised to ensure that they fulfill all necessary eligibility criteria before filling the online application form.

I. Minimum Eligibility:

1. The minimum educational qualifications for the post of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor shall be as per the Ordinance-4, Regulation-114 of Shaheed Mahendra Karma Vishwavidyalaya, Bastar and UGC Regulation 2018. Further, as per the decision of the Executive Council dated 21.03.2025, the applicants for different teaching posts must have master's degree with minimum percentage as specified by the UGC Regulation 2018 in the concerned subject. 2. The relaxation in the minimum percentage at master's level will be governed by the provisions of the UGC Regulation 2018. In addition to it, such applicants may have earned the Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/related subject.
3. The applicants for different teaching posts in such subjects where UGC NET/SET (from Chhattisgarh State) examinations are not conducted must have master's degree in the concerned subject and have Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/related subject.
4. Candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign universities should enclose "Certificate of Equivalence", issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will be rejected.
5. The eligibility of the applicant will be determined on the basis of the last date of submission of the application form.
6. Candidates applying for the posts of Professor or Associate Professor, and claiming teaching experience, must enclose salary slips, form-16, and ITRs for that duration, and present copies of the same along with the application form.

II. Age:

7. Applicants' maximum age should not exceed 65 years as on the last date of application form submission.

After online submission of the application form, an applicant will be permitted to edit the application form during the allowed time window as shown above. Once the edit window closes, request for change(s) correction(s) will not be allowed.

14. Incomplete applications or application form received after the last date will be summarily rejected.
15. In case, the last date fixed for receipt of application forms is declared a holiday, next working day shall be deemed to be the last date for receiving the forms.
16. Candidates are advised to mention their correct mobile number and email ID in the application form and to ensure that both remain valid until the completion of the recruitment process.
17. Candidates are requested to number all pages of their attached documents and mention enclosure number.

VI. General Information:

18. The formal communication pertaining to this advertisement, namely, Eligibility/Not-Eligibility related notices by the university will be published on the university website and call for interview and other direct communication will be made by e-mail and registered post/speed post. Candidates are advised to visit the website of the university (www.smkvbastar.ac.in) and check their emails regularly for updates.

19. Application submitted but not accompanied by necessary supporting verifiable documents, self-attested copies of mark sheets/degree certificates/experience certificates/category certificate (if applicable), publications, teaching/research experience issued by the competent authority and the incomplete application forms shall be rejected summarily.
20. Each research score, claimed by the candidate, must be supported by documentary evidence which will be objectively verifiable, without which no claim on account of the research score would be entertained. The research score will be finalized by scrutiny committee.
21. The prescribed qualifications/experience is the minimum criteria and the mere possession and fulfilling the essential and desirable qualifications of the same does not entitle the candidates to be called for the interview.
22. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate shall be treated as a disqualification which shall lead to cancellation of candidature.
23. The University reserves the right to:
 - a) Withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
 - b) Change the number of post (s) advertised if circumstances so warrant.
 - c) Not to fill up any of the advertised post (s) if circumstances so warrant.
 - d) Amendments/changes/corrigendum, if any, regarding this advertisement/recruitment issued by the university shall be available on the university website www.smkvbstar.ac.in

VII. Reservation Rules:

24. The benefit of reservation for candidates belonging to the SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Women/Persons with Disabilities (Divyang) categories shall be applicable only to candidates who are domiciled in the State of Chhattisgarh and shall be governed by the prevailing rules, orders, and notifications issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Chhattisgarh.
25. Candidates belonging to the reserved categories SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) shall submit self-attested copies of their permanent caste certificate issued by the competent authority, along with a valid permanent residence (domicile) certificate of the State of Chhattisgarh. In the absence of these documents, such candidates shall be considered under the unreserved category.
26. Candidates of OBC (Creamy Layer) category of Chhattisgarh state will be treated as Unreserved (UR).
27. The appointment under the reserved category shall be provisional and subject to the certificate being verified through the proper channels. If the verification reveals that the claim of the candidate to a particular category is false, his/her services will be terminated forthwith/without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice. In such cases, further action as may be, taken under the provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita for production of false certificates.
28. Persons with Disabilities (PwD/Divyang):
 - (i) Candidates applying under quota reserved for Persons with Disabilities (PwD/Divyang) should indicate whether he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) or Unreserved Category.

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- (ii) A candidate of specified disability (e.g. OA, OL, BL, B, LV) may apply in different vertical categories as shown in the advertisement for each department.
- (iii) The posts mentioned in Columns 13 is reserved exclusively for Persons with Disabilities (PwD/Divyang) candidates belonging to the State of Chhattisgarh.
- (iv) Persons with a disability of 40% or more shall be eligible to avail the benefit of reservation under the Persons with Disabilities category.
- (v) Persons with Disabilities (PwD/Divyang) shall enclose a hard copy of the medical certificate with the application, clearly specifying the type of disability (OA/OL/BL/B/LV) and the percentage of disability, in the prescribed format of the Government of Chhattisgarh, duly issued by the competent authority of the State of Chhattisgarh.

VIII. No Objection Certificate:

29. Applicant already in employment shall be required to submit NOC (No Objection Certificate) from the current employer either at the time of submission of application form or at the time of interview, failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear before the Selection Committee.

IX. Document Verification:


30. Shortlisted candidates are required to bring along all the original documents at the time of interview for verification. In case the candidate fails to produce the original copy of the claimed document, his/her claim will be rejected.

X. In case of selection:

31. In case of selection, the original certificates regarding relevant educational qualification, experience, publication, awards etc. along with caste certificate (for SC, ST, OBC candidate) and disability certificate (for person with disability) will have to be presented before the university authority.
32. The university shall verify the documents submitted by the candidates at the time of appointment and/or any time during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted are fake or if the candidate has concealed any information regarding criminal background, pending court cases, departmental inquiry, expulsion/termination from any institution, or any other adverse record, his/her services shall be terminated forthwith.
33. The candidate appointed to the post shall be required to undergo a probation period of three (03) years from the date of joining.
34. It will be mandatory for the candidate (if selected) to submit the certificate of being found fit for the service by Divisional Medical Board of Chhattisgarh.


XII. Disposal of Dispute:



